## Notice of Public Workshop

Review of Truckee River Water Quality Standards

**January 29, 2014**

The Bureau of Water Quality Planning of the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) has begun a review of the Truckee River water quality standards contained in Nevada Administrative Code 445A.1682 through 445A.1694. The current standards were last updated in 1993 and a new review is deemed appropriate.

With oversight from NDEP and EPA, the Cities of Reno and Sparks, TMWRF, Washoe County, and TMWA have been leading a 3rd party review of the nutrient portion of the water quality standards for the lower Truckee River (below East McCarran Drive). The results of the 3rd party effort will be considered by NDEP in a review of all the Truckee River standards. A workshop to present the results of the 3<sup>rd</sup> party modeling efforts will be held at the following location at the date and time indicated:

The workshop will consist of a brief presentation of the model findings followed by a question and answer period. No items will be voted on and no actions will be taken. Written comments on the modeling report or any other aspects of the standards review may be submitted to NDEP until April 3, 2014.
