On behalf of Jungo Land & Investments, Inc., this letter is a response to your letters dated May 26, 2010 (Review of Volume III Plan of Operations) and August 4, 2010 (Comments on Jungo Landfill Groundwater Monitoring Plan, and Nevada Division of Wildlife Questions and Requests for Information).

In response to comments presented in the above referenced correspondence, the relevant sections of the application package have been revised and are as follows:

- Report of Design (Revision 4, Revised September 2010): Revised to include additional information on the hydraulic properties of the subsurface soils.

- Groundwater Monitoring Plan (Revision 2, September 2010): Modified to reflect the three phase program as requested by NDEP.

Golder Associates Inc. (Golder) is submitting revised permit documents for the Jungo Disposal Site in response to Nevada Division of Environmental Protection's (NDEP's) letters dated May 26, 2010 and August 4, 2010. NDEP's May 26, 2010 letter addresses the Operations Plan (Volume III) and requests the inclusion of an Integrated Sitewide Contingency Plan (ISCP). NDEP's August 4, 2010 letter addresses the following issues:

- NDEP requested modification of the Groundwater Monitoring Plan to include a phased implementation
- NDEP requested additional information on the hydraulic properties of the subsurface soils
- NDEP requested Golder provide the design specification for the Colorado Silica Sand filter pack used to construct the site groundwater monitoring wells
- NDEP transmitted questions provided by the Nevada Department of Wildlife (NDOW)

The following documents address NDEP's comments regarding the ISCP, Groundwater Monitoring Plan, and hydraulic properties of the soils. They supersede and replace portions of the previous submittals:

- Operations Plan text (Revision 3, September 2010) and Table 1: Modified to include an ISCP that will be submitted to NDEP for review and approval at least 180 day prior to initiating any disposal operations
- Groundwater Monitoring Plan (Revision 2, September 2010): Modified to reflect the three phase program requested by NDEP
- Report of Design Text (Revision 4, September 2010): Modified to include additional information on the hydraulic properties of the subsurface soils

The Colorado Silica Sand used for the filter pack is the "10/20 Colorado Silica Sand" product. The product design specifications are attached.

Responses to NDOW questions are provided by Recology in a separate letter.
