V. CERTIFICATION

I certify under penalty of law that all stormwater discharges associated with Mining, Industrial, or Construction activity from the identified site that is authorized by the General Permit have been eliminated or that I am no longer the operator at the site. (Elimination of all stormwater discharges associated with construction activity occurs when disturbed soils at the construction site have been finally stabilized and temporary erosion and sediment control measures have been removed or will be removed at an appropriate time. Final stabilization means that all soil-disturbing activities at the site have been completed, and that a uniform perennial vegetative cover with a density of 70% of the native cover for unpaved areas and areas not covered by permanent structures has been established, or equivalent permanent stabilization measures (such as the use of riprap, gabions, or geo-textiles) have been employed.) I understand that by submitting this notice of termination, I am no longer authorized to discharge stormwater associated with Mining, Industrial or Construction activity under the NPDES Stormwater General Permit, and that discharging pollutants in stormwater associated with Mining, Industrial or Construction activity to waters of the United States is unlawful under the Clean Water Act where the discharge is not authorized by an NPDES permit. I also understand that the submittal of this Notice of Termination does not release an operator from liability for any violations of this permit or the Clean Water Act.

**Instructions to Complete the Notice of Termination (NOT) of Coverage under the
NPDES General Permit for Stormwater Discharges
Associated with Mining, Industrial or Construction Activity**

Who May File a Notice of Termination (NOT) Form?

Permittees who are presently covered under a Nevada-issued National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (“NPDES”) General Permit must submit a Notice of Termination (“NOT”) form when their facilities no longer have any stormwater discharges associated with the activity as defined in the stormwater regulations at 40 CFR 122.26, or when they are no longer the operator of the site.

Elimination of all stormwater discharges associated with construction activity occurs when disturbed soils at the construction site have been finally stabilized and temporary erosion and sediment control measures have been removed or will be removed at an appropriate time. Final stabilization means that all soil-disturbing activities at the site have been completed, and that a uniform perennial vegetative cover with a density of 70% of the native cover for unpaved areas and areas not covered by permanent structures has been established, or equivalent permanent stabilization measures (such as the use of riprap, gabions, or geo-textiles) have been employed.

Section I. Permit Information

If all stormwater discharges at the facility or site have been terminated, check the “Yes” box. If you are filing this NOT because of a change in ownership or for some other reason, please check the “No” box and indicate the reason for filing the NOT in the space below the boxes.

Enter your existing NPDES Stormwater General Permit Identification Number (e.g. CSW-xxxx, ISW-xxx, or MSW-xxx) assigned to the site. If you do not know the permit number, contact NDEP’s stormwater coordinator. Enter the date of termination due to either stabilizing the site or changing the ownership of the site.

If the owner or operator of a site changes, one of the following conditions apply:

- a) When the owner or operator of a site changes, the original owner listed on the permit shall submit a NOT at least ten (10) days before the change in ownership and list pertinent information concerning the new owner. The new owner shall then submit a Notice of Intent (“NOI”) at least ten (10) calendar days before the change in ownership. The site will be assigned a new permit identification Number (e.g. CSW-xxxx, ISW-xxx, or MSW-xxxx). This new Site ID needs to be listed in Section III. All transfer of permits shall be approved by NDEP.

OR

- b) If control or ownership of the project changes, the permittee shall notify the succeeding owner or controller of the existence of this permit by letter, a copy of which shall be forwarded to NDEP. To transfer permit coverage, the new owner or controller must submit a written request to NDEP. All transfer of permits shall be approved by NDEP.

Section II. Site Owner/Operator Information:

Give the legal name of the person, firm, public organization, or any other entity that owns or operates the site described in this NOT. The operator of the facility is the legal entity that controls the site's operation, rather than the plant or site manager. Do not use a colloquial name. Enter the complete contact information of the owner/operator, including mailing address, telephone number and email address.

Section III. New Site Owner/Operator Information:

If control or ownership of the project changes, the permittee shall notify the succeeding owner or controller of the existence of this permit by letter, a copy of which shall be forwarded to NDEP. To transfer permit coverage, the new owner or controller must submit a written request to NDEP. All transfer of permits shall be approved by NDEP.

Give the legal name of the new person, firm, public organization, or any other entity that will own or operate the site described in this section. The new operator of the facility is the legal entity that will control the site's operation, rather than the plant or site manager. Do not use a colloquial name. Enter the complete contact information of the new owner/operator, including mailing address, telephone number and email address. The new owner operator should also indicate whether a new NOI has been submitted to NDEP. If this has been done, the new Site acronym should be added (e.g. CSW-xxxx, ISW-xxx, or MSW-xxxx).

Section V. Certification:

Federal statutes provide for severe penalties for submitting false information on this application form.

Federal regulations require this application to be signed as follows:

For a corporation: by a responsible corporate officer, which means: (i) president, secretary, treasurer, or vice-president of the corporation in charge of a principal business function, or any other person who performs similar policy or decision making functions, or (ii) the manager of one or more manufacturing, production, or operating facilities employing more than 250 persons or having gross annual sales or expenditures exceeding \$25 million (in second-quarter 1980 dollars), if authority to sign documents has been assigned or delegated to the manager in accordance with corporate procedures;

- For a partnership or sole proprietorship: by a general partner or the proprietor; or
- For a municipality, State, Federal, or other public facility: by either a principal executive officer or ranking elected official.
