Subject: **NOTICE OF DECISION**

PERMIT INFORMATION: Permit **NVG870001** - Developed to authorize discharges of pesticides to **Waters of the U.S.** pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes **NRS 445A.465**

PERMIT DESIGNATION: **NVG870001**

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP), Bureau of Water Pollution Control (BWPC) has made the decision to issue a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System General Permit - **NVG870001** - for pesticide discharges in the State of Nevada. This permit authorizes qualifying operators to discharge pesticides, fungicides, herbicides, rodenticides and insecticides to **Waters of the U.S.** provided that they comply with all permit conditions. Sufficient information has been provided, in accordance with Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 445A.228 through NAC 445A.263, to ensure the BWPC that waters of the State will not be degraded from these activities and that public safety and health will be protected.

This permit will become effective **October 31<sup>st</sup>, 2011** and will expire on **October 31<sup>st</sup>, 2016**. The final determination may be appealed to the State Environmental Commission pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 445A.605. The appeal must be requested within ten (10) days of the date of this notice of decision and in accordance with the administrative rules of the Commission.
