<sup>2</sup>State-endorsement is granted to WHP plans that meet specific criteria set by the State. A number of plans, developed through separate funding sources or prior to the establishment of endorsement criteria, have not yet satisfied state-endorsement criteria as of this reporting.

<sup>3</sup>State-endorsed WHP plans are eligible to receive assistance from the State WHP Program to implement protection activities at the local level.

<sup>4</sup>Implementation of Watershed Control Program (WCP) is enforced by the Bureau of Safe Drinking Water for surface water systems receiving filtration avoidance (NAC 445A.525).

<sup>5</sup>Source Water Protection (SWP) implementation tally represents the sum of WHP and WCP implementation.
