Subject: New and Update UIC Forms

This memorandum is a notification that the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP), Underground Injection Control Program has created new forms, updated older forms and has updated the UIC forms section on the NDEP website.

Please visit the UIC forms section at <http://ndep.nv.gov/bwpc/forms.htm#uic> to become familiar with this revised list. Some older forms have been updated with new UIC form numbers.

New UIC Water Sampling Form U230

Due to continued issues with UIC water samples and documentation, the program will begin requiring new UIC Form U230 to be submitted with **all** UIC water samples effective October 1, 2010. These forms will be required with all water samples submitted to the UIC program including:

1. UIC applications
2. With all samples submitted with UIC reports
3. Any other sample submitted for UIC review

October 1, 2010 is the effective date for beginning to use new UIC Form U230 with all sampling events and subsequent submittals to the UIC Program. Any water sample collected after October 1, 2010 submitted to the UIC program without this form and all necessary items completed on the form for that particular type of sample will be an undocumented sampling event and deemed invalid.

Important Note: the UIC program requests all permit holders visit the UIC forms section to determine if a form has been updated. All submittals must be made on the most recent form version.
