

**Notice of Workshops
to Solicit Comments on Proposed Amendments to
NAC 445B.001-3497
AIR CONTROLS: AIR POLLUTION**

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) is proposing changes to the section of Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 445B that deals with public notification provisions for minor revisions to Class I operating permits and to update definitions. A public workshop has been scheduled in Reno to solicit comments from interested persons.

The proposed amendments will:

- Remove duplicate requirements for public notification and participation in the processing of minor revisions to Class I operating permits in the following cases:
 - When the Director drafts proposed conditions for an operating permit because the applicant's proposed conditions were not adequate, and
 - If the Administrator of U.S. EPA objects to the proposed revision, and the Director subsequently revises the proposed revision.
- Remove definitions that are no longer used in NAC 445B.

Members of the public who are disabled and require special accommodations or assistance at the meeting are requested to notify Lin Wilson no later than 5 business days before the workshop.
