Notice Of Intent To Amend Regulation
May 5, 2004

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes, NRS 233B.0603. The Administrator is proposing to make two amendments on the Pretreatment Regulations, Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 445A.257. The proposed amendments to this regulation are to strike the requirement for the Division to administer a pretreatment program for municipalities that do not have an approved pretreatment program.

The estimated adverse immediate and long-term economic effects of the proposed revisions to these regulations on the business, which it is to regulate is minimal. The Division still will be able to implement a pretreatment program as it deems necessary.

There is not likely any potential for a beneficial or detrimental immediate economic effect of the proposed revisions on the business, which this regulation is to regulate. The Division has not attempted to quantify this long-term beneficial effect.

The proposed regulation amendments are not expected to expand the number of facilities requiring permits, therefore, the estimated cost to the Division for enforcement of the proposed regulation will be minimal.

All comments or objections received within the thirty (30) day period will be considered in the formulation of final determinations regarding the proposed regulation amendment. If the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.
