The Bureau of Mining Regulation and Reclamation of the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection is proposing a change to one regulation contained within the NAC 445A mining regulations. Workshops will be held February 13 and February 17, 2006.

The proposed regulation revises mine operator responsibility with respect to spent ore and also clarifies some acceptable methods to demonstrate stabilization of spent ore.
