Notice of Public Workshops

The Bureau of Mining Regulation and Reclamation of the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection is proposing amendment to a limited section of the NAC 445A mining regulations (R138-06). Public workshops will be held August 22 and 23, 2006 to discuss the proposed changes.

The proposed revision provides correction and clarification in the description for several fee categories of mining facility permits under NAC 445A.232. The proposed amendment changes the language from discharge of process water to discharge of dewatering water, and also clarifies the tonnage categories to be the annual capacity at which the facility is designed to operate. Please note that no adjustments are being proposed in either the permit fee or tonnage amounts.

The public workshops will consist of a brief presentation of the proposal by the Division, followed by a question and answer period. Workshops will be held at the following locations and times:
