## PUBLIC NOTICE

The Administrator, Nevada Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada, is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Administrative Code 444.570 through 444.7499, inclusive, and under the Nevada Revised Statutes 444.440 through 444.620, inclusive.

The Administrator has received a complete application to modify an existing permit for an expansion of the Class III Construction and Demolition (C&D) debris site from the following applicant:

### **City of Ely, Nevada**

The applicant is seeking authorization to modify and expand the operation of the Class III disposal site at: Lakawanna Road, Approximately 1 mile northeast of the City of Ely [T16N/R63E/Section10 MDB&M]

On the basis of a review of the requirements of the Nevada Administrative Code, the Administrator intends to issue a permit modification to allow the expansion of the Class III Disposal Site as described in the permit modification application. The applicant or any interested persons may submit written comment(s) on this proposed intent by the Administrator regarding permit issuance or request a public hearing pursuant to the Nevada Administrative Code by submitting their comments or request, in writing, by July 3<sup>rd</sup> 2006 to:

A request for a public hearing must state the nature of the issues the requester intends to raise at the hearing. The Administrator may extend the period for public comment as necessary. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit issuance, the Administrator may schedule a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued and published in a newspaper of local interest at least 30 days before the date of the hearing. A statement responding to written comments will be issued. Copies of the statement will be sent to the applicant, person(s) who submitted the written comments, and all other persons who specifically

request, in writing, a copy of the statement. A copy of the statement will be made available for inspection by the general public at a location to be determined by the Administrator.

Within 30 days after the end of the period for public review, the Administrator will either issue or deny a permit to operate the disposal site, and send a written notice to the applicant.
