STUDENTS! Job shadow a resource professional

♦ **WHAT:** *Snapshot Day* is a citizen-based water quality monitoring event.

♦ **WHY:** Learn about your local Truckee River Watershed and collect data that provides a "snapshot" in time of water quality and stream conditions.

♦ **HOW:** Citizen monitoring teams led by water-resource professionals will field-test streams for dissolved oxygen, conductivity, pH and temperature; collect water samples for laboratory analysis of nutrients, sediment and bacteria; and conduct visual habitat assessments of the sites. Team leaders will share interesting watershed facts and provide information about how you can improve and protect your watershed.

♦ **WHEN:** Saturday, May 12, 2007
9:00 am – 12:00 pm (noon)

♦ **WHERE:** Meet at Bartley Ranch to get your team and stream assignments.


