Notice of Proposed Action

April 29, 2008

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes.

The Administrator has received a complete application for renewal of water pollution control discharge permit #NEV96017 from the following applicant:

Black Mountain Golf and Country Club operates the Black Mountain Golf Course, including a driving range and common areas at 500 Greenway Road in Henderson, Clark Co., Nevada. The Permittee has applied for renewal of a permit for continued reuse with tertiary treated, denitrified and disinfected effluent supplied by the City of Henderson Water Reclamation Facility (#NEV80003), on the 27 hole Black Mountain Golf and Country Club. Irrigation is conducted via spray and drip irrigation. Irrigation reuse is conducted in accordance with conditions set forth in the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection approved Effluent Management Plan and the permit. The proposed permit is for a period of (5) five years.

On the basis of preliminary review of the requirements of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and implementing regulations, the Administrator proposes to issue a permit to discharge, subject to certain effluent limitations and special conditions.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance or request a hearing pursuant to the Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control should submit their comments or request, in writing, within thirty (30) days either in person or by mail to:

All comments or objections received within thirty (30) days will be considered in the formulation of final determinations regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing date.

If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.
