## NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

Web posting 10/23/09

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes and the Clean Water Act. The Administrator has received a complete application for renewal of an existing water pollution control discharge permit, NEV2004511, from the following applicant:

Keith and Janet Kubichek

Winnemucca, Nevada 89445**

The Permittee proposes to land apply domestic septage, grease trap material, and sanitary wastewater from permitted commercial holding tanks pumped by the Applicant to agricultural land for beneficial use as a soil amendment and source of crop nutrients. The 50-acre land application site is located in the northwest corner of the Keith and Janet Kubichek property, near the intersection of Jungo Road and Cyanco Drive, west of Winnemucca, Nevada in Humboldt County. Domestic septage, grease trap material, and sanitary wastewater must be incorporated into the soil within six hours of land application. The Applicant will be authorized to store a maximum of 34,000 gallons of domestic septage and grease trap material on-site in five steel storage tanks. The Permittee will be required to plant a crop to utilize the nitrogen within one year of land application.

On the basis of preliminary review of the requirements of the Nevada Revised Statutes, as amended, and implementing regulations, the Administrator proposes to renew discharge permit NEV2004511, for a five (5) year period, subject to certain effluent limitations and special conditions.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance, or request a hearing pursuant to the Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control, should submit their comments or request, in writing, within thirty (30) days of the date of newspaper publication, hand-delivered or postmarked no later than **5:00 P.M. on November 30, 2009**, either in person or by mail to:

Comments and/or hearing requests received via facsimile or e-mail before **5:00 P.M. November 30, 2009** will also be accepted. All requests for hearings must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reason(s) why a hearing is warranted. All comments or objections received within the thirty (30) day comment period will be considered in the formulation of final determinations regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. The public notice of such hearings will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the

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public hearing date.

If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.
