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**Permittee Name: City of West Wendover**

**Permit Number: SW153REV01**

### Description of Proposed Modification

The City of West Wendover is requesting a modification to the current Permit to accept waste at greater than 20 tons per day therein becoming a Class I facility. West Wendover has also requested a separate Class III area for the disposal of Construction & Demolition Waste that had been formerly used as a part of the Class II operation.

### Proposed Action

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) is proposing to modify the Permit to accommodate the request.

The NDEP's Notice of Intent to approve a modification to the Permit for West Wendover authorizing a change to a Class I/III status subject to the conditions contained in the Permit, will be published in the **Elko Daily Free Press**. Additionally, the Public Notice will be mailed to interested persons on our mailing list. The NDEP will accept written comments and written requests for a public hearing on the proposed draft permit from all interested persons. Written requests for a public hearing must state the nature of the issues the requester intends to raise at the hearing. Written requests for a public hearing and written comments on the proposed draft permit will be accepted until the end of the public comment period.

### Will there be a public hearing?

The NDEP may schedule a public hearing on its own initiative or based on receipt of a written request received during the public comment period. Any interested person may submit a written request to the NDEP for a public hearing on the proposed action. The request must state the nature of the issues the



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requester intends to raise at the hearing. If a hearing is scheduled, the NDEP will notify all persons who are on the mailing list or who have submitted written comments on the proposed action.

### **When does the comment period end?**

The 30-day comment period ends **Friday September 12, 2009**. Anyone wishing to comment should do so **in writing** prior to this date. The NDEP may extend the comment period as deemed necessary.
