Description of Proposed Permit Modification

The existing groundwater monitoring network at the Valmy Ash Landfill installed between 1994 and 2001 has, due to changing groundwater conditions, necessitated a change in the monitoring network. Previously five groundwater monitoring wells had been installed and three have been determined to no longer provide reliable monitoring data. Consequently, NVEnergy has proposed the installation of three replacement wells in new locations to provide a more reliable monitoring network reflective of the disposal of Coal Combustion By-products from the operation of the adjacent facility.

Proposed Action

The Nevada NDEP of Environmental Protection (NDEP) is proposing to approve a Permit modification to accommodate the proposal.

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection's (NDEPs) Notice of Intent to approve a modification to the Permit for NVEnergy –Valmy Landfill subject to the conditions contained in the Permit, will be published in the **Humboldt Sun**. Additionally, the Public Notice will be mailed to interested persons on our mailing list. The NDEP will accept written comments and written requests for a public hearing on the proposed draft permit from all interested persons. Written requests for a public hearing must state the nature of the issues, which the requester intends to raise at the hearing. Written requests for a public hearing and written comments on the proposed draft permit will be accepted until the end of the public comment period.

Will there be a public hearing?

The NDEP may schedule a public hearing on its own initiative or based on receipt of a written request received during the public comment period. Any interested person may submit a written request to the NDEP for a public hearing on the proposed action. The request must state the nature of the issues which the requester intends to raise at the hearing. If a hearing is scheduled, the NDEP will notify all persons who are on the mailing list or who have submitted written comments on the proposed action.

When does the comment period end?

The 30-day comment period ends **Tuesday September 15, 2009**. Anyone wishing to comment should do so **in writing** prior to this date. The NDEP may extend the comment period as deemed necessary.
