Notice of Workshop to Solicit Comments on Proposed Amendments to Nevada Administrative Code Chapter 445B: Air Pollution

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) is proposing to amend four sections in the permitting provisions of NAC 445B to better align the state regulations with the Clean Air Act and U.S. EPA rule requirements. - NAC 445B.138, "Potential to emit" defined.
- NAC 445B.187, "Stationary source" defined.
- NAC445B. 311, Environmental evaluation: Contents; consideration of good engineering practice stack height.
- NAC 445B.313, Method for determining heat input: Class I sources.

The amendments are in response to U.S. EPA comments on the approvability of the NDEP's air pollution control permitting provisions into the Nevada State Implementation Plan.
