## PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

Web posting 5/6/10

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes. The Administrator has received a complete application for renewal of a water pollution control discharge permit NEV90055 from the following applicant:

Petro Source Refining Partners  
Eagle Springs Refinery  
HC 34 Box 34830  
Ely, Nevada 89301

The applicant operates an oil refinery approximately 11 miles south of Currant, Nevada State Route 6, in Nye County, Nevada. Non-contact and process related wastewaters generated at the facility are treated and discharged into a lined evaporation pond. The proposed Groundwater Discharge Permit is for a five (5) year period.

On the basis of preliminary review of the requirements of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and implementing regulations, the Administrator proposes to reissue the permit to discharge, subject to certain effluent limitations and special conditions.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance or who request a hearing pursuant to the Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control should submit their comments or request, in writing, within thirty (30) days, by **June 4, 2010** either in person or by mail to:

All comments or objections received within thirty (30) days, by **June 4, 2010**, will be considered in the formulation of final determinations regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing date.

If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.
