## Public Notice

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes. The Administrator has received a complete application for renewal of water pollution control permit #NEV93006 from the following applicant:

Carson City Parks Department  
3303 Butti Way  
Carson City, NV 89701

The applicant is permitted to apply secondary treated disinfected effluent supplied by the Carson City Water Reclamation Facility to the Upper Centennial Park, Saliman Road, Lone Mountain Cemetery, and Edmonds Sports Complex, Governor's Field, Lower Centennial Park and Northridge/Blackwell Pond Park as reuse irrigation sites via spray and drip irrigation of turf grasses and other plant materials. The renewed permit will cover a period of five (5) years.

On the basis of preliminary review of the requirements of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS), and implementing regulations, the Administrator proposes to reissue the Water Pollution Control Permit, subject to certain limitations and special conditions.

Persons wish to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance or request a hearing pursuant to the Nevada Administrative Code, for Water Pollution Control should submit their comments or request, in writing, within thirty (30) days of newspaper publication, by **March 20, 2010** either in person or by mail to:

The request must be filed within the comment period and must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted.

All comments or objections received within thirty (30) days will be considered in the formulation of final determinations regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing date.

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If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.
