NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

Web posting 1/6/10

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes and the Federal Clean Water Act. The Administrator has received a complete application for a new National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit, #NV0021750, from the following applicant:

**Las Vegas Hilton Hotel and Casino
3000 Paradise Road
Las Vegas, Nevada 89109**

The applicant operates a parking garage structure on Paradise Road. Groundwater seepage beneath the parking garage drains into the east and west basement collection sumps. The sump water is treated prior to discharge to the Clark County storm drain system. The storm drain system discharges the sump water to an outfall located at the Flamingo Wash. The discharge rate of basement seepage into the storm drain varies seasonally from 20,000 to 30,000 gallons per day (gpd), with a maximum permit limit of 120,000 gpd. Monitoring of the discharge is conducted to ensure that State surface waters are not degraded as a result of basement dewatering of the parking garage.

The Division has made the tentative determination to issue (renew) the proposed NPDES permit conditions to the applicant for a period of five (5) years.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance or request a hearing pursuant to the Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control should submit their comments or request, in writing or by Fax, within thirty (30) days of the date of newspaper publication, by **5:00 P.M. on February 10, 2010**, either in person or by mail to:

Comments and/or hearing requests received via facsimile or e-mail before **5:00 P.M. February 10, 2010** will also be accepted. All requests for hearings must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reason(s) why a hearing is warranted. All comments or objections received within the thirty (30) day comment period will be considered in the formulation of final determinations regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. The public notice of such hearings will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the public hearing date.
