PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

Web posting 8/19/10

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes and the Federal Clean Water Act. The Administrator has received an application for issuance of a new National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit, Permit # NV0023841, from the following applicant:

The Applicant owns the Somerset Shopping Center, which houses a dry cleaning establishment. Past activities have resulted in groundwater impacted with dry cleaning solvents. Groundwater remediation is accomplished using a groundwater and soil vapor extraction and treatment system. The water treatment system includes an aeration vessel, followed by two granulated activated carbon (GAC) vessels in series, which remove volatile organic compounds from the impacted groundwater. Treated groundwater is discharged to Las Vegas Wash via the Clark County storm drain system. Treatment capacity of the system is 60 gallons per minute (gpm); however, the Applicant has requested a permit flow limit of only 30 gpm. Based on a review of the NPDES permit application, the Division has made the tentative determination to issue the NPDES permit for a period of five (5) years.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding the issuance of the permit, or to request a hearing pursuant to the Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control, should submit their comments or request, in writing, within thirty (30) days of the date of newspaper publication, hand-delivered or postmarked no later than **5:00 P.M. on September 23, 2010**, either in person or by mail to:

Comments and/or hearing requests received via facsimile or e-mail before **5:00 P.M. September 23, 2010** will also be accepted. All requests for hearings must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reason(s) why a hearing is warranted. All comments or objections received within the thirty (30) day comment period will be considered in the formulation of final determinations regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. The public notice of such hearings will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the public hearing date.

If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.
