NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION PUBLIC NOTICE

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following Notice of Proposed Action under the authority of the Nevada Revised Statutes, the Nevada Administrative Code, and the Safe Drinking Water Act.

The Administrator has received a renewal application for an Underground Injection Control (UIC) permit, which has been drafted for public comment. Permit UNEV90017 have been applied for by the following applicants:

The applicant has submitted a renewal application for UIC permit UNEV90017 to inject fluids associated with conventional oil production into well #1-B and three other wells to be located in Sections 1, 2, 3, and 10, T8N, R57E, in Nye County, Nevada. The applicant is required to monitor injection pressure, annular pressure and rate; and is required to conduct periodic mechanical integrity tests of the wells and submit chemical analysis of the liquid injectate to demonstrate that degradation of the receiving formation will not occur. The injection zone has been characterized as a hydrocarbon producing zone.

On the basis of preliminary review, the Administrator has made a tentative determination to issue the UIC permit to authorize water discharge activities. Persons wishing to comment on or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance or to request a hearing pursuant to Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control, should submit their comments in writing by April 16, 2010 either in person or by mail to:

All comments or objections received within thirty days of newspaper publication will be considered in the formulation of final determinations regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty days prior to the hearing date. The application, draft permit, comments received, and other information are on file and may be copied at the office of the Division of Environmental Protection, or copies may be obtained by writing to the above address.
