

## NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

### PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) Chapter 445B, the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 445B, and the Clean Air Act, the Division of Environmental Protection is issuing the following notice.

The Director received an application for a new Class II Air Quality Operating Permit AP4911-3272 from:

Reno, NV 89511

The project is located at 1132 Gabbs Valley Road, Mineral County Nevada 89420. The Director has prepared tentative determinations regarding the operating permit that, in brief, are the following:

- The new permit is for new construction and operation of a geothermal plant which includes:
  - An Ormat Energy Converter
  - An Emergency Diesel Generator
  - An Emergency Fire Pump Diesel Engine
  - A 500 gallon Gasoline Storage Tank
- Emissions from the facility will not exceed 0.11 ton/year of PM<sub>10</sub>, 2.79 tons/year of NO<sub>x</sub>, 0.0034 ton/year of SO<sub>2</sub>, 50.43 tons/year of VOC, 1.63 tons/year of CO, and 4.30E-3 ton/year of HAP.
- No adverse ambient air quality impacts are expected.

On the basis of the preliminary review of the application and supporting information review and the requirements of the NRS, the NAC and the Clean Air Act, the Director is hereby announcing his intent to issue a new Class II air quality operating permit. Persons wishing to comment upon the proposed determinations by the Director regarding this proposed action should submit their comments in writing either in person or by mail or fax within thirty (30) days to:
