



**PUBLIC NOTICE FOR A RCRA PERMIT FOR A
 HAZARDOUS WASTE TREATMENT AND STORAGE FACILITY**

What is the Public Notice About?

This is a REQUEST FOR PUBLIC COMMENT on a Draft Permit to be issued as a renewal of the current permit under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) for the Treatment, Storage and Recycling of Hazardous Waste at the **21st Century Environmental Management of Nevada, LLC** (21EMN) facility in Fernley, Nevada. Upon renewal of the RCRA permit, 21EMN can continue to treat and store the waste identified in the Draft Permit. 21EMN stores, treats (by detoxification, dewatering and/or evaporation) and/or recycles acids, alkaline, metal-bearing liquids and sludge, cyanides, batteries, and other hazardous or household wastes.
