**Permittee Name: Lockwood Regional Landfill**

**Permit Number: SW214REV02**

#### Description of Proposed Permit Action

The Lockwood Regional Landfill will be expanded out to approximately 856 acres with a waste volume increase to approximately three hundred and two million cubic yards [302(10<sup>6</sup>)yds<sup>3</sup>]. The expanded area will be fully lined with leachate collection and removal. It will incorporate a Class I Municipal Solid Waste Site (MSW) & Class III Industrial Solid Waste Disposal facility.

#### Location

The Landfill is located approximately 15 miles east of Reno NV along the Interstate 80 corridor. Legal description—S ½ of Section 22, SW ¼ of Section 23, NW ¼ of Section 26, N ½ of Section 27 in Township 19 N, Range 21 East MDB&M in Storey County.

#### **Will there be a public hearing?**

The NDEP may schedule a public hearing on its own initiative or based on receipt of a written request received during the public comment period. Any interested person may submit a written request to the NDEP for a public hearing on the proposed action. The request must state the nature of the issues which the requester intends to raise at the hearing. If a hearing is scheduled, the NDEP will notify all persons who are on the mailing list or who have submitted written comments on the proposed action.

#### **When does the comment period end?**

The 30-day comment period ends at 5 p.m. on May 3<sup>rd</sup> 2013. Anyone wishing to comment should do so in writing prior to this date. The NDEP may extend the comment period as deemed necessary.
