**PUBLIC NOTICE FOR A RCRA PERMIT FOR A
 HAZARDOUS WASTE TREATMENT AND STORAGE FACILITY**

What is the Public Notice About?	This is a REQUEST FOR PUBLIC COMMENT on a Draft Permit to be issued as a renewal of the current permit under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) for the Treatment of Hazardous Waste at the Hawthorne Army Depot (HWAD) New Bomb facility in Hawthorne, Nevada. Upon renewal of their RCRA permit, HWAD New Bomb can continue to treat the waste identified in the Draft Permit. HWAD New Bomb treats (by open detonation) explosive waste military munitions.
