PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) Chapter 445B, the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 445B, and the Clean Air Act, the Division of Environmental Protection is issuing the following notice.

The Director received an application for a NEW Class II Air Quality Operating Permit AP4911-3364 from:

Presco Energy, LLC
Rye Patch Geothermal Power Plant
4500 S. Humboldt Road, Exit 138, I-80 East
Lovelock, Nevada 89419

The proposed project is located at 4500 S. Humboldt Road, Exit 138, I-80 East, in Pershing County, Nevada. The Director has prepared tentative determinations regarding the operating permit that, in brief, are the following:

- The new permit is for new construction and operation of a Geothermal Power Plant facility.
- The new permit is subject to Federal NESHAP requirements pursuant to 40 C.F.R. Part 63, Subpart ZZZZ.
- Emissions from the facility will not exceed 0.04 ton/year of PM₁₀, 1.69 tons/year of NO_x, 0.01 ton/year of SO₂, 5.52 tons/year of VOC, 0.51 ton/year of CO, and less than 10.0 tons/year of any individual HAPs and less than 25.0 tons of total combination of HAPs.
- No adverse ambient air quality impacts are expected.

On the basis of the preliminary review of the application and supporting information review and the requirements of the NRS, the NAC and the Clean Air Act, the Director is hereby announcing his intent to issue a revised Class II air quality operating permit. Persons wishing to comment upon the proposed determinations by the Director regarding this proposed action should submit their comments in writing either in person or by mail or fax within thirty (30) days to:
