NOTICE OF INTENT - Bureau of Mining Regulation and Reclamation

The Administrator of the Division of Environmental Protection (Division) gives notice that an application for a Reclamation Permit for a mining operation for the **Cloverdale Placer Project** has been properly filed with the Division in Carson City. The applicant for Permit 0356 is:

**Action Enterprises Nevada, LLC
3165 Santa Maria Drive
Concord, CA 94518**

This project, will be located within Nye County, and is in Section 24, Township 8 North, Range 39 East; Mount Diablo Baseline & Meridian, Nye County, Nevada, approximately 40 miles north of the community of Tonopah, Nevada. The Cloverdale Placer Project will be a surface mine using gravity separation to recover gold and other heavy minerals. The mining and processing will take place on a privately-owned 40 acre parcel. The open pit will be concurrently backfilled with stockpiled washed gravels and sediments from the plant site so that the volume of excavated material will not exceed 22,000 cubic yards at any given time.

The Administrator is constrained to issue the Reclamation Permit or to deny the application. The Administrator has made the tentative decision to issue the reclamation permit.

Persons wishing to submit written comments or information on the draft of the permit must do so in writing no later than by 5 PM on May 27, 2014. Any person who is directly affected by the application for a permit may request, in writing, a public hearing on the application for a permit. The request must state the reason for the request and the issues to be raised at the hearing. This request must be submitted, in writing, no later than by 5 PM on May 27, 2014.

All comments, objections or requests received during the public notice period will be considered in the final determination regarding this Reclamation Permit. If the Division determines written comments or requests are reasonable and indicate a significant degree of public interest in this matter, the Administrator shall schedule a public hearing in accordance

with the requirements of NAC 519A.200. The Division will accept written comments in the form of facsimile, e-mail, or by mail. The comments may also be hand delivered.

The draft Reclamation Permit and all application documents are on file at the Division and are available for public inspection and copying pursuant to NRS Chapter 239.010.
