

## **NOTICE OF INTENT - Bureau of Mining Regulation and Reclamation**

**Deadline for Comments: 07/24/2015**

The Administrator of the Division of Environmental Protection (Division) gives notice that an application for a major modification to a Reclamation Permit for a Mining Project for the **Pumpkin Hollow Project** has been properly filed with the Division in Carson City. The applicant for the major modification to Permit 0288 (Permit) is:

This project will be located within Lyon County, and is in portion(s) of Section 35 of Township 13 North, Range 26 East; Sections 2-4 and 9-11 of Township 12 North, Range 26 East; Mount Diablo Baseline & Meridian, approximately 8 miles southeast from the community of Yerington, Nevada. This proposal significantly increases the disturbance acres for ore processing mills, two open pits, an expanded dry stack tailings facility, a new larger waste rock storage facility and increased infrastructure disturbance acreage for roads, yards and water management.

The Administrator is constrained to issue the Reclamation Permit or to deny the application. The Administrator has made the tentative decision to issue the reclamation permit.

Persons wishing to comment upon the proposed Permit, to recommend terms and conditions for consideration of incorporation in the Permit, or who request a public hearing pursuant to Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 519A.190, must submit their written comments, objections, or requests by hand delivery, facsimile, e-mail transmittal or US Postal Service, no later than 5:00PM of the 30<sup>th</sup> day following the date of publication of this notice, June 24<sup>th</sup>, 2015 to:

All comments, objections or requests received during the public notice period will be considered in the final determination regarding this Permit. If the Division determines written comments or requests are reasonable and indicate a significant degree of public

interest in this matter, the Administrator shall schedule a public hearing in accordance with the requirements of NAC 519A.200.
