

NOTICE OF INTENT - Bureau of Mining Regulation and Reclamation

The Administrator of the Division of Environmental Protection (Division) gives notice that an application for a new Reclamation Permit for an Exploration Project for the **Snowstorm Exploration Project** has been properly filed with the Division in Carson City. The applicant for the new Permit 0363 (Permit) is:

This project will be located within Humboldt County, and is in portions of Sections 1, 9-12, 14-16, and 20-36, Township 41 North, Range 43 East; Sections 1-5, 8-13, and 16-17, Township 40 North, Range 43 East; Sections 4-8, Township 40 North, Range 44 East; Mount Diablo Baseline and Meridian, approximately 44 miles from the community of Winnemucca, Nevada. This is an exploration project consisting of construction of roads, drill pads and sumps. The total disturbance for this project will be 200 acres.

The Administrator is constrained to issue the Reclamation Permit or to deny the application. The Administrator has made the tentative decision to issue the reclamation permit.

Persons wishing to comment upon the proposed Permit, to recommend terms and conditions for consideration of incorporation in the Permit, or who request a public hearing pursuant to Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 519A.190, must submit their written comments, objections, or requests by hand delivery, facsimile, e-mail transmittal or US Postal Service, no later than 5:00PM on August 3, 2015 to:

All comments, objections or requests received during the public notice period will be considered in the final determination regarding this Permit. If the Division determines written comments or requests are reasonable and indicate a significant degree of public interest in this matter, the Administrator shall schedule a public hearing in accordance with the requirements of NAC 519A.200.
