**WPC Permit No. NEV0094113 (2015 Renewal)
Nevada Milling and Mining, LLC
Coyote-Blossom Mine Project**

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection has decided to issue a Renewal of Water Pollution Control Permit NEV0094113 to Nevada Milling and Mining, LLC. This permit authorizes the construction, operation, and closure of approved mining facilities in Clark County. The Division has been provided with sufficient information, in accordance with Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 445A.350 through NAC 445A.447, to assure the Division that the groundwater quality will not be degraded by this operation, and that public safety and health will be protected.

The permit will become effective 30 January 2015. The final determination of the Administrator may be appealed to the State Environmental Commission pursuant to Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 445A.605 and NAC 445A.407. All requests for appeals must be filed by 5:00 PM, 25 January 2015, on Form 3, with the State Environmental Commission, 901 South Stewart Street, Suite 4001, Carson City, Nevada 89701-5249.
