



## NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes and/or the Clean Water Act, where applicable. The Administrator has received an application for a Groundwater Discharge , permit number NS0098019 from the following applicant:

### **Permit NS0098019, LEXINGTON AT REVERE GOLF CLUB:**

Core Revere, LLC operates the Lexington at Revere Golf Club (LRGC), an 18-hole golf course in Henderson, Nevada. The LRGC proposes to continue discharging reclaimed water supplied by the City of Henderson's Southwest Water Reclamation Facility (SWRF) for irrigation of up to 76 acres of the golf course and common areas. The SWRF supplies tertiary-treated, disinfected reclaimed water that meets Category B quality in accordance with NAC 445A.276. Reclaimed water usage for the LRGC is estimated to be 942 acre-feet per year (0.84 million gallons per day). The SWRF has authorized the LRGC to use up to 942 acre-feet of reclaimed water per year.

On the basis of preliminary review of the requirements of the Nevada Revised Statutes, as amended, and implementing regulations, the Administrator proposes to issue Permit NS0098019 to discharge for a five (5) year period, subject to certain effluent limitations.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance, or request a hearing pursuant to the Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control, should submit their comments or request, in writing, within thirty (30) days of the date of newspaper publication, hand delivered or postmarked no later than 5:00 P.M. on 11/15/2015 , either in person or by mail to:

The request must be filed within the comment period and must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. All comments or objections received within the thirty (30) day period will be considered in the formulation of final determination(s) regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing date.

If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.
