



## NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the authority of the Nevada Revised Statutes and the Safe Drinking Water Act.

The Administrator has received a renewal application for Underground Injection Control (UIC) permit UNEV94218, which has been drafted for public comment. Renewal of this permit has been applied for by: **Nevada Environmental Response Trust, LePetomane XXVII, Inc. 35 East Wacker Drive, Suite 1550 Chicago, IL 60611**

The applicant has submitted a renewal application for a UIC permit associated with the Nevada Environmental Response Trust (NERT) Henderson facility, 510 South Fourth Street, Henderson, Nevada. The applicant is currently performing remediation of chromium and perchlorate groundwater contamination at the facility, and has requested renewal of the permit to inject clean Lake Mead water into two injection trenches located on site. Monitoring at the facility will continue to be required to ensure that groundwater is not degraded due to injection activities.

On the basis of preliminary review of the requirements of the Nevada Revised Statutes and the Safe Drinking Water Act, and implementing regulations, the Administrator proposes to renew permit UNEV94218 as stated above.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance, or to request a hearing pursuant to Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control, should submit their comments or request in writing by June 30, 2015 either in person or by mail to: Division of Environmental Protection Bureau of Water Pollution Control Attn: Russ Land 901 S. All comments or objections received within thirty days of newspaper publication will be considered in the formulation of final determinations regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty days prior to the hearing date.
