

NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

Pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) Chapter 445B, the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) Chapter 445B, and the Clean Air Act, the Division of Environmental Protection is issuing the following Notice of Proposed Action.

The Director received an application for a new Class I (Title V) Air Quality Operating Permit, AP4953-3616 (FIN A0020) from the following applicant:

The City of Elko operates the Elko Municipal Landfill, located at 2200 Pinion Road, Elko, Nevada. The Elko Municipal Landfill is located in all or portions of Sections 13 and 18, Township 34N, Ranges 55E and 56E (MDB&M). The Director has prepared a tentative determination regarding the proposed new Class I (Title V) Air Quality Operating Permit. In brief, the project includes the following:

- The Elko Municipal Landfill accepts a variety of solid waste for disposal. The facility also has a variety of supporting equipment such as an emergency generator, building heaters, and organic liquid storage tanks.

On the basis of the preliminary review and the requirements of the NRS, the NAC and the Clean Air Act, the Director is hereby announcing his intent to issue the proposed new Class I (Title V) Air Quality Operating Permit based on a review of the information submitted.
