Lake Mead, the largest reservoir by volume in the United States, provides habitat for numerous wildlife species, including several threatened and endangered species, as well as diverse recreational opportunities for more than 8 million visitors annually. It plays a critical role in water management in the Southwest, with its stored waters providing drinking water for more than 20 million people and water to irrigate over 2.5 million acres of croplands. Of great concern are issues arising from the challenges of drought and potential climate change impacts, the

introduction of the invasive quagga mussel, and urbanization within tributary watersheds. The Lake Mead Science Symposium provides an opportunity for resource managers and researchers to share information, exchange ideas, and synthesize efforts on the ecological health of Lakes Mead and Mohave within the Lake Mead National Recreation Area. It is a state-of-the-science event intended to disseminate information from recent research, and enhance opportunities for collaborative management.
