

NDEP will recommend reimbursement for the following CEM-owned in-house materials and rental equipment, not to exceed the below summarized costs, only. Proposed costs for items that do not appear in the tables should be calculated using the CEM Equipment Usage Rate Calculation provided in Appendix C. A CEM usage log must accompany each claim requesting reimbursement for all in-house equipment rental and materials costs. **Because allowable state rates are subject to change, NDEP urges the CEM to contact Fund staff at (775) 687-9368 or check our website at <https://ndep.nv.gov/environmental-cleanup/petroleum-fund> for the latest information regarding allowable rates.**
