<sup>3</sup>State-endorsed WHP plans are eligible to receive assistance from the State WHP Program to implement protection activities at the local level.

<sup>4</sup>Implementation of Watershed Control Program (WCP) is enforced by the Bureau of Safe Drinking Water for systems receiving filtration avoidance (NAC 445A.525).

<sup>5</sup>The Source Water Protection (SWP) implementation tally represents the sum of ISWP and WCP implementation.
