Permit 55627 [Klondike #2] (142)	Pumpage / <i>Continue filing quarterly reports.</i> PBU / <i>Continue filing extensions for PBU as needed.</i> Correct POD / <i>Recommendation: The State Engineer's office has stated that a change of POD may be applied for at the same time as filing PBU, documenting the current POD with the corrected quarter-quarter information. No map changes or additional surveys required.</i>
4.	Certificate 5160 [Stockwatering well] (142)	MOU/ <i>Recommendation: The permitted MOU is not consistent with current use. Apply to change MOU, POD and POU to same as water right permit 60963, then abandon the well.</i>
5.	Certificates 2795 [Goldfield #1]	Duty/ <i>Recommendation: The water rights associated with these certificates are not being exercised. It is recommended that the County evaluate each POD to determine if it is appropriate to formally bring the water right under the water utility by applying for a change in POD and POU. A possible POD may be the Klondike well field POD where the water's POU is the utility's service area. A portion of the duty/POD may be moved to the Pozo Spring site if that site could be developed. This process would also necessitate abandoning the former POD's that could be found and identifying a total combined duty. The water right documented by certificate 6201 (Shriver) has a significant duty of 1,448 AF/year to be considered. This water could benefit the Town of Goldfield if some type of industry can be attracted that needs water for their operations.</i>

17.	Certificate 7670 [Cemetery well] (142)	<i>Recommendation: Provide the discharge with a meter and commence recording pumpage.</i>
18.	Certificate 8754 [Indian Springs] (142)	<i>Recommendation: Arsenic concentrations at the water right's POD have been tested at 0.050 mg/l and this is not otherwise a workable source. It is recommended the POD be changed to an existing source such as the Klondike well field.</i>
19.	Certificate 9902 [Silver Peak W01] (143)	<i>Recommendation: The water right associated with this certificate is not being exercised. It is recommended that the County apply for a change in POD and POU. An alternative POD and POU may be that documented under the Silver Peak W02 well. This process would also necessitate re-identifying the TCD and abandoning the former POD if found.</i>
20.	Certificate 9894 [Silver Peak W02] (143)	Pumpage / <i>Continue filing quarterly reports.</i>
21.	Permit 69220 [Silver Peak W03] (143)	Pumpage / <i>Continue filing quarterly reports</i> PBU / <i>Continue filing extensions for PBU as needed.</i>
22.	Certificate 13632 [Gold Point Ranch Springs] (144)	<i>Recommendation: Provide the discharge with a meter and commence recording pumpage.</i>
23.	Permit 60964 [Hot Box Spring] (117)	<i>Recommendation: The current MOU for this water right is "Recreation". Given the County may find cause to utilize this water source for road maintenance, it is recommended that a change application be made to a Municipal MOU that would include this specific use of the water source.</i> Pumpage / <i>Continue filing quarterly reports</i> PBU / <i>Continue filing extensions for PBU as needed.</i>
