

What is the Nevada “7-11 test”?

The Nevada Department of Environmental Protection (NDEP) allows the use of a pared-down version of the EPA TCLP. The “pared-down” test is referred to as the “7-11 test”. The “7-11 test” analyzes only 7 metals, and 11 organics rather than the full TCLP.

The “7-11 test” should only be considered for wastes that that are under your control. The “7-11” should never be used for unknowns.

The table below lists the analytes of the “7-11 Test”
