Subject: Incompleteness Review

Dear Ms. Supp:

Thank you for your application to construct a Class III C& D Landfill for the City of Wells. In accordance with NAC 444.641(1) the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) finds it to be incomplete. As the land is currently owned by the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) the BLM would be the owner identified in the Permit. Accordingly, the BLM would need to assume the responsibility for closure and post closure care. As the BLM is an entity of the Federal Government they would need to acknowledge responsibility for the closure/post-closure costs for the site, once constructed, until a patent transfer had taken place. Please submit an acknowledgment by the BLM for financial responsibility by April 24<sup>th</sup>, 2011. Please note that the BLM is exempt from establishing an actual financial instrument pursuant to NAC 444.685.23
