6. Solid waste permitted for disposal:
 in accordance with the Waste Acceptance Criteria in the approved Waste Characterization Plan, to wit, municipal and industrial solid waste in the form of garbage, rubbish, and debris.

7. Prohibited wastes:
 as specified in the Waste Characterization Plan.

8. The following documents, submitted by the permittee and approved by the Division of Environmental Protection, describe, restrict, limit, and condition the operation, closure, and postclosure stages authorized by Permit SW 13 097 04:

- (a) Plan of Operations;
- (b) Waste Characterization Plan;
- (c) Report of Design;
- (d) Plan for Closure;
- (e) Plan for Monitoring Water;
- (f) Plan for Postclosure.

9. The following conditions are incorporated and made part of this permit:

- (a) compliance with the applicable and relevant portions of NRS 444.440 through 444.620 and NAC 444.570 through 444.7499;
- (b) the annual report is due on the first Friday after the first day of March of each year and shall include:
 - (A) all off normal conditions experienced during the calendar year;
 - (B) all exceptions to the Waste Acceptance Criteria; and
 - (C) the weight and volume of waste disposed in each calendar year, both annual and quarterly totals.


All reports shall be signed, dated, and delivered to the Solid Waste Program Manager, Bureau of Federal Facilities, Division of Environmental Protection, 555 East Washington Street, Suite 4300, Las Vegas, Nevada, 89101.

10. This permit is consistent with NRS 444.440 through 444.620 and with NAC 444.570 through 444.7499 and is consistent with Part 258 in Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations. This permit may be modified, pursuant to NAC 444.643.2, if the statutes and regulations upon which the permit is based change or in order to protect the public health or the environment.

11. This permit shall endure until the period for postclosure is exhausted, unless revoked pursuant to NAC 444.643.5. The terms, restrictions, conditions, and limitations of this permit are effective and enforceable after midnight on

12 December 1997.
