Public Notice of Intent to Issue
a Permit for a Class III
Solid Waste Disposal Site

The Administrator of the Division of Environmental Protection has received a complete Application from the U.S. Department of Energy/Nevada Operations Office for a permit to operate a Class III Solid Waste Disposal Site, pursuant to Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 444.6405. The Class III Solid Waste Disposal Site is to be located on the Nevada Test Site, Nye County in Nevada State Plane Coordinates N 20451324 feet to N 20451826 feet by E 1849131 feet to E 1848949 feet. The permit application will restrict acceptable wastes for disposal at the permitted facility to asbestos and asbestos-containing materials with a low-level radioactive component and minor quantities of hydrocarbon-burdened soil and debris with a low-level radioactive component.

The proposed permit application and supplemental information will be available for public review and comment for a period of thirty (30) days beginning March 1, 2000 and ending on March 30, 2000. All interested parties may review these documents during standard business hours at:

Nevada during the public participation period defined above. All comments will be considered in the final determination to issue the permit or deny the application.

Any interested party, including the permit applicant, can submit in writing a request that the Administrator conduct a public hearing with respect to matters related to the tentative determination to issue the permit. Each written request must be received by the Carson City office of the Division of Environmental Protection at the above listed address not later than March 30, 2000.
