Specific industrial wastes permitted for disposal: Solid waste generated by the construction, refurbishing, or demolition of buildings or other structures.		
Special wastes permitted for disposal: waste tires.

7. Prohibitions:		
The permittee shall restrict the types and amounts of liquids disposed of according to NAC 444.693. The permittee is prohibited from accepting the following wastes:		
Hazardous waste, as defined by State and Federal Regulations. Regulated medical waste, liquid sewage sludge and septic tank pumpings, friable asbestos, hydrocarbon-contaminated soils and refrigerators containing freon and other freon containing devices.		
8. The following documents*, as submitted by Pershing County and approved by the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection, also describe and/or restrict the operation of this disposal site:		
(a) Plan of Operations (b) Report of Design	(c) Plan for Closure (d) Plan for Postclosure Care	(e) Response to technical review dated 01/09/98.
*The Application for a Permit to Operate a Class II Municipal Landfill is composed of the above documents dated August 15, 1997 and as amended January 9, 1998.		
9. The following conditions are also incorporated as a part of this permit:		
(a) Compliance with NRS 444.440 through 444.620, inclusive, and NAC 444.570 through 444.7499.		
(b) Special waste disposal conditions: Quantities of waste tires greater than ten (10) shall be either (a) buried with C&D waste that is disposed of separately from municipal solid waste, or, if codisposed with municipal solid waste, (b) placed in a single layer and covered with a compacted layer of cover material at least as thick as the layer of tires.		
(c) Complete documentation of financial assurance in compliance with NAC 444.685 to NAC 444.6859, inclusive, shall be entered into the operating records of the site by April 9, 1998. The Division shall be notified when the documentation has been placed in the record.		
(d) The Applicant will continue to submit semi-annual waste receipt reports to the Division. In addition, the Applicant will notify the Division when, and if, the incoming waste stream approaches the 20-ton-per-day maximum for Class II facilities. At that time, provisions for converting to a Class I facility will be made and will be subject to approval by the Division.		

10. Findings:

- a. This permit is consistent with NAC 444.440 through 444.620, inclusive, and NAC 444.570 through 444.7499, inclusive.
- b. This permit is consistent with Federal landfill regulations found in 40 CFR Part 258.
- c. This facility is compatible with local land use planning.
- d. A municipal solid waste management plan has been submitted to NDEP. This plan reflects the proposed disposal site.

11. This permit is approved based on the information given in the permit application, and the Addendum to the permit application approved by the Nevada Division of Environmental Protection. This permit may be modified by the Division if the statutes or regulations upon which the issuance of the permit is based change, or if a modification is otherwise necessary to protect public health and safety and the environment. Any discrepancies between information contained in the permit application and the actual construction and operation of the facility may be grounds for revocation of this permit and appropriate enforcement action. The permittee must inform the Division of any deviation from or change in the information in the application which may affect the permittee's ability to comply with applicable regulations or conditions of the permit. This permit may be revoked if written notice is given by the Division and compliance with permit conditions and applicable statutes and regulations is not maintained.
