for Incline Village & Crystal Bay



Did you know that each person in the United States produces an average of eleven pounds of hazardous waste per year? That's 1.6 million tons!

Common household items such as compact fluorescent light bulbs, batteries and cleaners contain toxic chemicals which can pollute water and soil. These should NOT be disposed of in the trash. These chemicals may be labeled: flammable, toxic, explosive or poisonous.

These chemicals are especially hazardous if they are not stored properly or are left to accumulate in one place. **Get them out of your home and into our HHW center!**

LIQUID OR POWDER HAZARDOUS WASTE MUST BE IN ORIGINAL CONTAINERS!

Limits: 5 gallons or less or total 50 lbs. at one time. Commercial accounts, we cannot service you but please contact Waste Not for referrals. We also do not accept: antifreeze, car batteries or vehicle oils, these can be recycled at the Waste Management Transfer Station, 7 days a week. Info: (775) 831-2971.

Bring items (liquids or powders in original containers) to 1220 Sweetwater Rd, IVGID Public Works upper parking lot, on Tues. & Thurs. from 3-5 pm. Show proof of residency and its FREE! IVGID pays the additional disposal costs.
