The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action in accordance with Nevada Revised Statutes. The Administrator has received a complete application to renew Authorization to Discharge:

Permits NEV92015 authorize the use of reclaimed effluent supplied by the Carson City Utility Department Wastewater Reclamation Plant for irrigation of landscaped areas. Permit NEV92015 authorizes a maximum flow rate of 1.5 million gallons per day. At a minimum, reclaimed water is treated to meet secondary standards, nitrified, and chlorine disinfected prior to distribution for reuse. Groundwater monitoring and discharge monitoring requirements are stipulated in the proposed permit renewals. Renewed permits, upon re-issuance, remain in effect for a five (5) year period.

Based on preliminary review of NRS and implementing regulations, the Administrator proposes to re-issue the permit to discharge, subject to the limitations and conditions imposed. Comments or requests for a hearing, pursuant to Nevada Administrative Code-Water Pollution Control, regarding the proposed Administrative determination(s) should be submitted, in writing, to:

Comments or objections must be received within the 30-day comment period, which begins on the date of this publication, and must be postmarked or received via fax or email before 5:00 PM PDT on June 6, 2005 will be considered in the formulation of final determination(s). If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. Public notice of such

hearing will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing date. If a hearing is not held and the determination(s) of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will publicly notice the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.
