**Notice Of Proposed Action**

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes and the Clean Water Act. The Administrator has received an application for a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit, NV0022420, from the following applicant:

The Applicant proposes to continue operate a groundwater remediation system at the former UNOCAL Station 7313 located at 101 North Decatur Boulevard, Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada 89107. Prior leakage of gasoline from underground storage tanks has contaminated the shallow groundwater with petroleum hydrocarbon contaminants. The groundwater remediation system consists of groundwater removal via a recovery trench followed by a sediment filter and a shallow tray air stripper for the removal of volatile organic contaminants. The treatment system will continue to be limited to a maximum discharge flow rate of 30 gallons per minute, 0.043 million gallons per day. The treated effluent will continue to be discharged to a storm drain inlet that conveys the treated groundwater to the Las Vegas Wash. Monitoring is required to ensure that the discharge meets water quality standards prior to discharge. The Division has made the tentative determination to issue the proposed permit for a period of five (5) years from the expiration date of the previous permit.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance, or request a hearing pursuant to the Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control, should submit their comments or request, in writing, within thirty (30) days of the date of newspaper publication, postmarked no later than 5:00 P.M. on September 24, 2005, either in person or by mail to:

The request must be filed within the comment period and must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. All comments or objections received within the thirty (30) day period will be considered in the formulation of final determinations regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing date.

If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.
