NOTICE OF FINAL DECISION  
RECLAMATION PERMIT NO. 0236

**Golden Phoenix Minerals, Inc.**  
**Alder Creek Ranch Pilot Molybdenum Test Milling Project**

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) has decided to issue Reclamation Permit, No. 0236, for a Mining Project to Golden Phoenix Minerals, Inc. This permit authorizes Golden Phoenix Minerals, Inc. to reclaim the Alder Creek Ranch Pilot Molybdenum Test Milling Project. This Project is located in Humboldt County, Nevada. The Division has been provided with an application, in accordance with Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) and Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 519A to assure the Division that Golden Phoenix Minerals, Inc. will leave the project site safe, stable, and capable of providing for a productive post-mining land use.

This permit will become final on February 6, 2005. The final determination of the Administrator may be appealed to the State Environmental Commission pursuant to NAC 519A.415. The appeal must be filed by February 5, 2005, and in accordance with Administrative rules of the Environmental Commission.

One comment was received during the public comment period from the Nevada Division of Water Resources and has been duly noted.
