Public Notice of Proposed Action

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes. The Administrator has received a complete application for water pollution control discharge permit (NEV20067500 from the applicant:

The applicant proposes to construct and operate the Churchill County Moody Lane Regional Water Reclamation Facility which is to be located on a 40 acre site on Moody Lane in northwest Fallon in Section 14, T. 19N., R. 23E. MDB&M. This new regional facility will serve new and existing customers in the area west of Fallon in Churchill County, Nevada. The new water reclamation facility is designed to treat the domestic sewage to meet tertiary treatment standards via a Membrane Bioreactor with biological nutrient removal. The effluent will be denitrified and disinfected prior to reuse on approved sites. Winter storage of treated effluent onsite is planned, with other approved disposal options possible proximal to the facility. The permit will cover a five (5) year period.

On the basis of preliminary review of the requirements of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) as amended and implementing regulations, the Administrator proposes to issue a permit to discharge, subject to certain limitations and special conditions.

Persons wish to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance, or request a hearing pursuant to the Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control, should submit their comments or request, in writing, within thirty (30) days of the date of newspaper publication, by November 12, 2006, either in person or by mail to:

The request must be filed within the comment period and must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. All comments or objections received within thirty (30) day period will be considered in the formulation of final determinations regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of

public interest in the proposed permit, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing date.

If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.
