## Notice of Intent

The Administrator of the Division of Environmental Protection gives notice that an application for a Reclamation Permit for the Spring Valley Exploration Project has been properly filed with the Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) in Carson City. The applicant for Permit # 258 is:

This project, will be located within Pershing County, and is in portion(s) of Section 35, Township 29 N, Range 34 E, M.D.B. & M, approximately 25 miles from the community of Lovelock, Nevada. The exploration project is a mixture of public and private land (11.46 acres) that was previously authorized under Notice level by BLM and through an Interim Reclamation Permit by NDEP.

The Administrator is constrained to issue the reclamation permit or to deny the application. The Administrator has made the tentative decision to issue the reclamation permit.

Persons wishing to submit written comments or information on the tentative decision, must do so in writing no later than by 5 PM on DECEMBER 9, 2006. Any person who is directly affected by the application for a permit may request, in writing, a public hearing on the application for a permit. The request must state the reason for the request and the issues to be raised at the hearing. This request must be submitted, in writing, no later than by 5 PM on DECEMBER 9, 2006.

All comments or objections received during the public notice period will be considered in the final determination regarding this application. If the Division determines written comments or requests are reasonable and indicate a significant degree of public interest in this matter, the Administrator shall schedule a public hearing in accordance with the requirements of NAC 519A.200. The Division will accept written comments in the form of facsimile, e-mail, or by mail. The comments may also be hand delivered.
