PUBLIC NOTICE OF PROPOSED ACTION

The Administrator, Division of Environmental Protection, Carson City, Nevada is issuing the following notice of proposed action under the Nevada Revised Statutes. The Administrator has received a complete application for a water pollution control effluent reuse discharge permit (NEV2007505) from the applicant:

**The Golf Course at Fallon, Inc.
2655 Country Club Drive
Fallon, Nevada 89406**

The applicant has applied for a discharge permit to use secondary treated, denitrified, disinfected effluent for reuse irrigation at The Golf Course at Fallon located at 2655 Country Club Drive in Fallon, Nevada. The applicant has been using groundwater and river water for irrigation of the golf course, but will use treated effluent as the primary water with the former waters as supplements to the irrigation system. The treated effluent (reuse) water will be supplied by the new Churchill County Wastewater Treatment Plant located at 2655 Clubhouse Drive, on the golf course, in Fallon. Reuse irrigation will be conducted in accordance with an approved Effluent Management Plan and the terms and conditions of this permit. Monitoring will be required. The permit will be issued for a five (5) year period.

On the basis of preliminary review of the requirements of the Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) as amended, and implementing regulations, the Administrator proposes to issue a permit to discharge, subject to certain effluent limitations and special conditions.

Persons wishing to comment upon or object to the proposed determinations by the Administrator regarding permit issuance, or request a hearing pursuant to the Nevada Administrative Code, Water Pollution Control, should submit their comments or request, in writing, by April 12, 2007, within thirty (30) days of the date of newspaper publication, either in person or by mail or FAX (775)687.4684 to:

The request must be filed within the comment period and must indicate the interest of the person filing the request and the reasons why a hearing is warranted. All comments or objections received within the thirty (30) day period will be considered in the formulation of

final determinations regarding the application. If written comments indicate a significant degree of public interest in the proposed permits, the Administrator shall hold a public hearing. A public notice of such hearing will be issued not less than thirty (30) days prior to the hearing date. If no hearing is held and the determinations of the Administrator are substantially changed from the tentative determinations, the Administrator will give public notice of the revised determinations. Additional comments and objections will be considered at that time.
